

2025 Summer Camp Scholarship Application Instructions

Thanks to a donation by the Fischer Family Foundation, Calusa Nature Center and Planetarium (CNCP) is proud to offer a limited number of one-week summer camp scholarships for students ages 8-14 (rising second through eighth graders).

Campers will have multiple opportunities for exploring outdoors, hiking our trails, working hands-on with captive animals like turtles and snakes, creating nature-based crafts and attending educational shows in our planetarium. With weekly themes like "Junior Naturalist" and "Outdoor Survival", each day is geared to diving deeper into the topic and inspiring children to enhance their appreciation for nature.

To apply, submit the following THREE items:

- 1) Letter from the child answering these questions:
 - a. What is your favorite thing to do outside?
 - b. Why do you want to go to this camp?
- 2) Letter from a teacher, guidance counselor or other professional with close familiarity with the student:
 - a. Describe your relationship with the camper and how long you have known them.
 - b. Why is this student worthy of the scholarship?
 - c. How would this student benefit from the scholarship?
- 3) Parent/Guardian will need to fill out the application (pages 2 and 3) and forward all materials (items 1, 2 and 3) in ONE email to:

Application review will begin in April and awardees will be notified by April 30, 2025. Applications received after April 30 will be reviewed if scholarships are still available or there is a cancellation. Each child should have a separate application. Campers are eligible for one 1-week scholarship per summer.
